It's Better by Bus

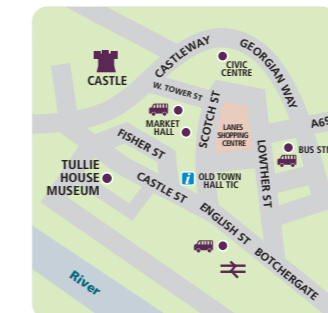

On leaving the train station, cross the forecourt, the AD122 leaves from the bus stop on English Street near the large sandstone archway.

On leaving Newcastle Central Station, turn right and AD122 stop is located on Neville St, at stop number 124.

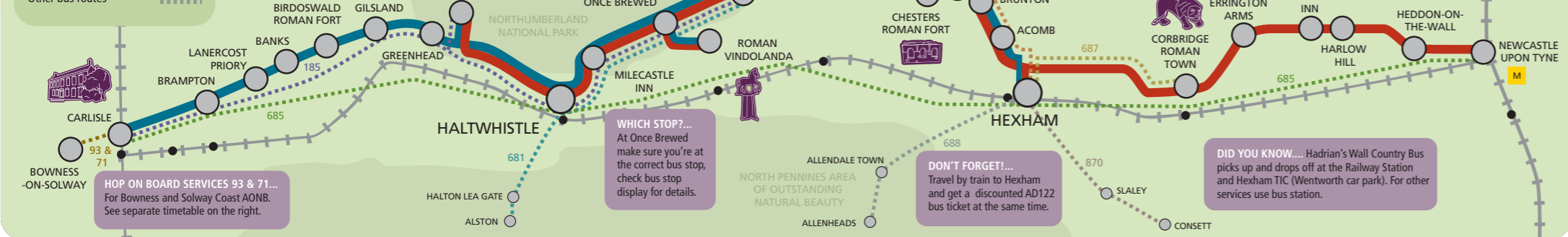

The all year 93 service is operated by Stagecoach in Cumbria partly supported by Cumbria County Council.

DID YOU KNOW... The service operates from the bus station that is only a 10 minute walk from the AD122 English Street stop.

IT'S WORTH KNOWING...
The AD122 picks up and drops off in the car park at Housesteads which is 50 metres from National Trust visitor centre.

RELAX... There are regular bus and train links between Newcastle and Hexham so don't worry if you sleep in and miss the 9.00am bus, more regular departures from Hexham to the Wall.

REMEMBER... There are numerous bus and metro connections from Newcastle to the Great North Museum, Segedunum and Arbeia.

WHICH STOP?... At Once Brewed make sure you're at the correct bus stop, check bus stop display for details.

DON'T FORGET!... Travel by train to Hexham and get a discounted AD122 bus ticket at the same time.

DID YOU KNOW...! Hadrian's Wall Country Bus picks up and drops off at the Railway Station and Hexham TIC (Wentworth car park). For other services use bus station.

Walking

Use the bus to plan your walk along the Hadrian's Wall Path National Trail and a network of paths gives a choice of linear and circular walks from bus stops along the route. There is something for everyone from the estuary and salt marshes of the Solway Coast Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty teeming with bird life to the wild Whin Sill crags (with some of the best-preserved sections of the Wall) and loughs of Northumberland National Park.

Pedal Power by Bus

Hadrian's Wall Country is great for cycling offering the Hadrian's Cycleway (NCN route 72) that runs the length of the World Heritage Site and numerous other do-in-a-day rides (half day rides for the less energetic) exploring quiet roads and tracks. Many of these connect with the Bus. A limited number of cycles can be carried if booked in advance for free through the Hadrian's Wall Information Line on 01434 322002 no later than 3.00pm prior to the day of travel. Some buses have dedicated cycle carriers.

The AD122 also picks up/drops off at the following points:
Between Newcastle and Hexham: General Hospital, Plaza Bingo Hall, Fox and Hounds Inn, Denton Burn, Lemington Road End, Blucher Social Club, Walbottle Campus, Throckley Roundabout, Royal French Arms, Harlow Hill, Robin Hood, Errington Arms.

Between Hexham and Carlisle: Acomb, Wall, Brunton Crossroads, Chollerford Roundabout, Tower Tye, Brocolitia, the Old Repeater Station, all marked stops on Haltwhistle Main St, Banks.

The AD122 Hadrian's Wall Country Bus is run by Alba Travel in Cumbria and Classic Coaches in Northumberland.

AD122 Single Adult Fares - Main Stops

An example of how to calculate a **single fare** is shown here e.g. Hexham to Housesteads £3.20. With a **return fare** at one and half times single fare, the return journey would be £4.80. Simple!

Children: aged from 5 to 16 years inclusive half adult fare

Concessionary travel: English concessionary passes are accepted

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I use my concessionary pass?
Yes. English national concessionary passes allow free travel on the AD122 service after 9.30 in the morning (after 9.00am in Northumberland).

Can I use my disabled pass?
Yes you can, disabled pass holders can travel for free all day. All AD122 buses are low floor easy access.

Can I take my dog with me on the bus?
Yes. Well behaved dogs are allowed at no extra charge.

What do the Guides do?
The on-bus Guides bring your journey to life with an introduction to Hadrian's Wall Country and will answer all your questions. They even have some interesting objects to handle!

Can I book the bus for large groups?
No, but call the Hadrian's Wall Information Line and we will try to accommodate your group.

Where can I buy tickets?
You can buy all your tickets on the bus but also Rover 1, 3 & 7 day tickets are available at tourist information centres at Carlisle, Haltwhistle, Hexham and Newcastle.

Why is there only one departure per day from Newcastle?
There are very good bus and train links between Newcastle and Hexham to connect with the frequent AD122 service from Hexham to the Wall.

Can I take my bicycle on the bus?
Yes. Call the Hadrian's Wall Information Line for details.

- On some of the Roman Sites, you can find friendly Volunteer Heritage Guides who will take you around the Roman remains, bringing them to life! Go to hadrians-wall.org for information.
